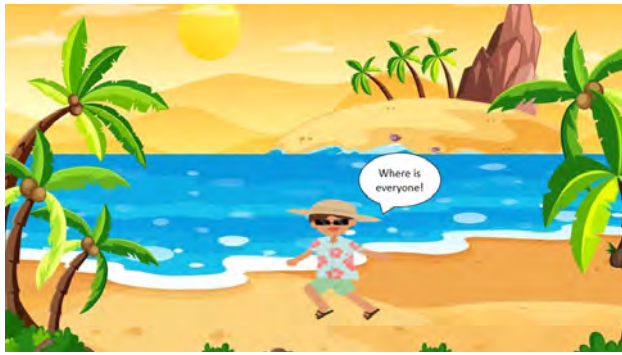
Even though we missed the Year 5s, we had a great time performing on the stage. We were nervous at that start, but once we started to sing our nerves went away and we had a blast!

Thank you to our parents and teachers for giving us the opportunity to experience this wonderful event. We definitely recommend that all Year 5/6 students join choir next year!

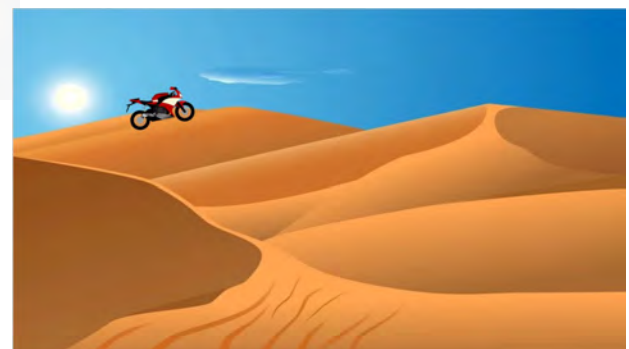
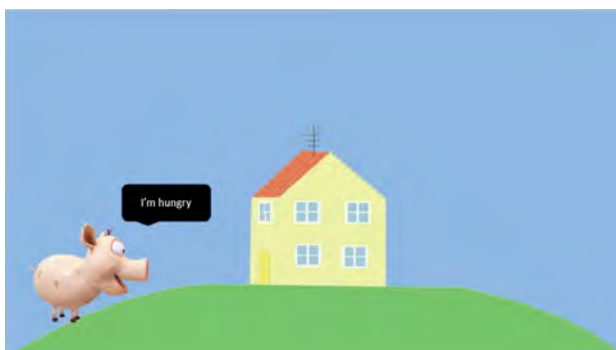
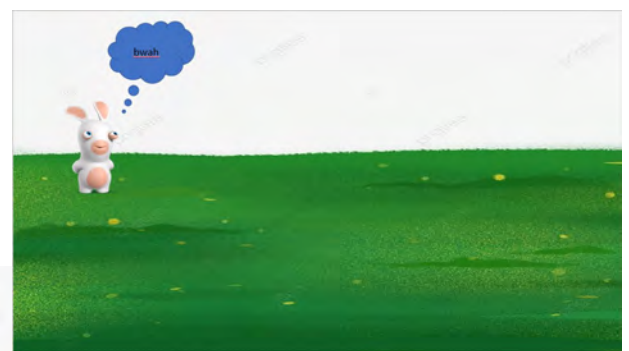






# AMAZING ANIMATIONS

Junior, Middle and Upper Primary students had a great time testing their skills by playing all sorts of fun games and activities.

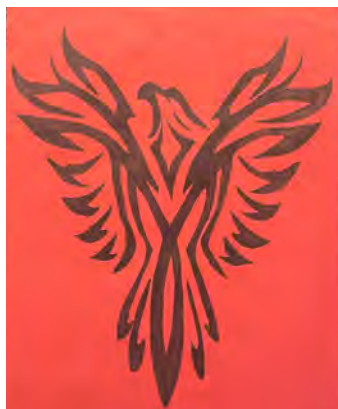
