NAPLAN 2023

The NAPLAN assessments will start on Wednesday 15th March, and run over a two week period. During this time, year 3 and 5 students will complete 4 assessments: Writing, Reading, Conventions of Language, and Mathematics. Teachers will send out more information about the assessments and exact dates via Class dojo.

Year 3 and year 5 students have already sat a NAPLAN practice test. The practice test is designed to test the capacity of our computer network and allows students the opportunity to log in and see the types of questions that they will need to complete. Students took the opportunity to practice very seriously, and I am positive that they will give each of the assessments 100% effort.
