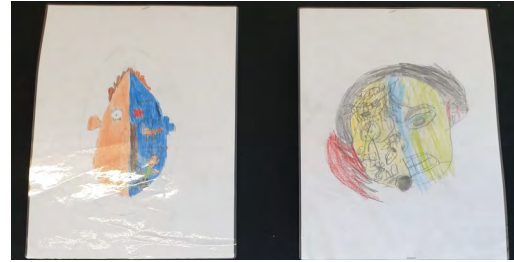
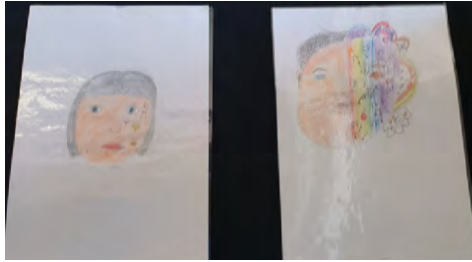
Harmony Day

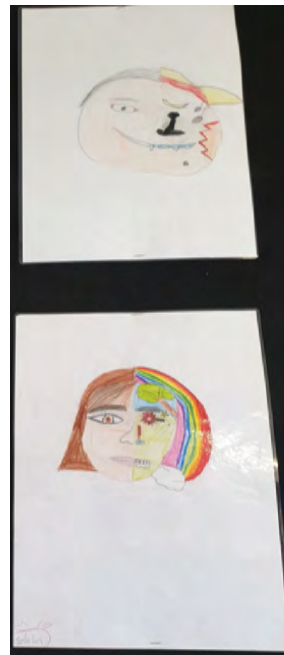
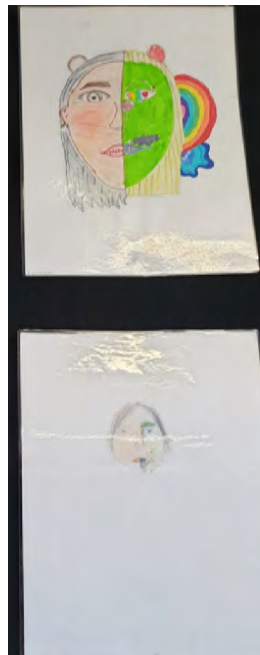
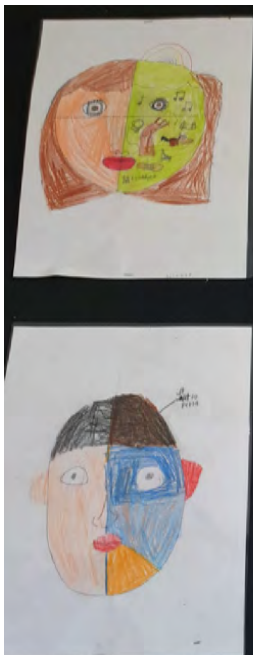


Inner and Outer Self-Portraits

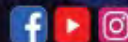
